

Things need before starting your application process.

1. You need knowledge about the program you want to apply for.
2. You need to have personal and school documents with you.
3. Have you calculated your APS (Admission Point Score)?
4. You need a device with internet access (good internet connection is necessary).
5. You will need an email address and cell phone number that are active and have access to.
6. Make sure you complete your application in full (so that there is no delay in responses).
7. If you have any queries during the online application process, you can email or call the institution, alternatively contact RBI-SGSS.



THINGS TO CONSIDER

1. If you want to study law. You need to know which law programme you want to study.

These are some of the UJ Law requirements. If you want to study at UP, you will need to investigate UP Law Faculty requirements.

6. Open www.uj.ac.za – study@uj – new applicant (follow the application process till you complete it/submit it).
